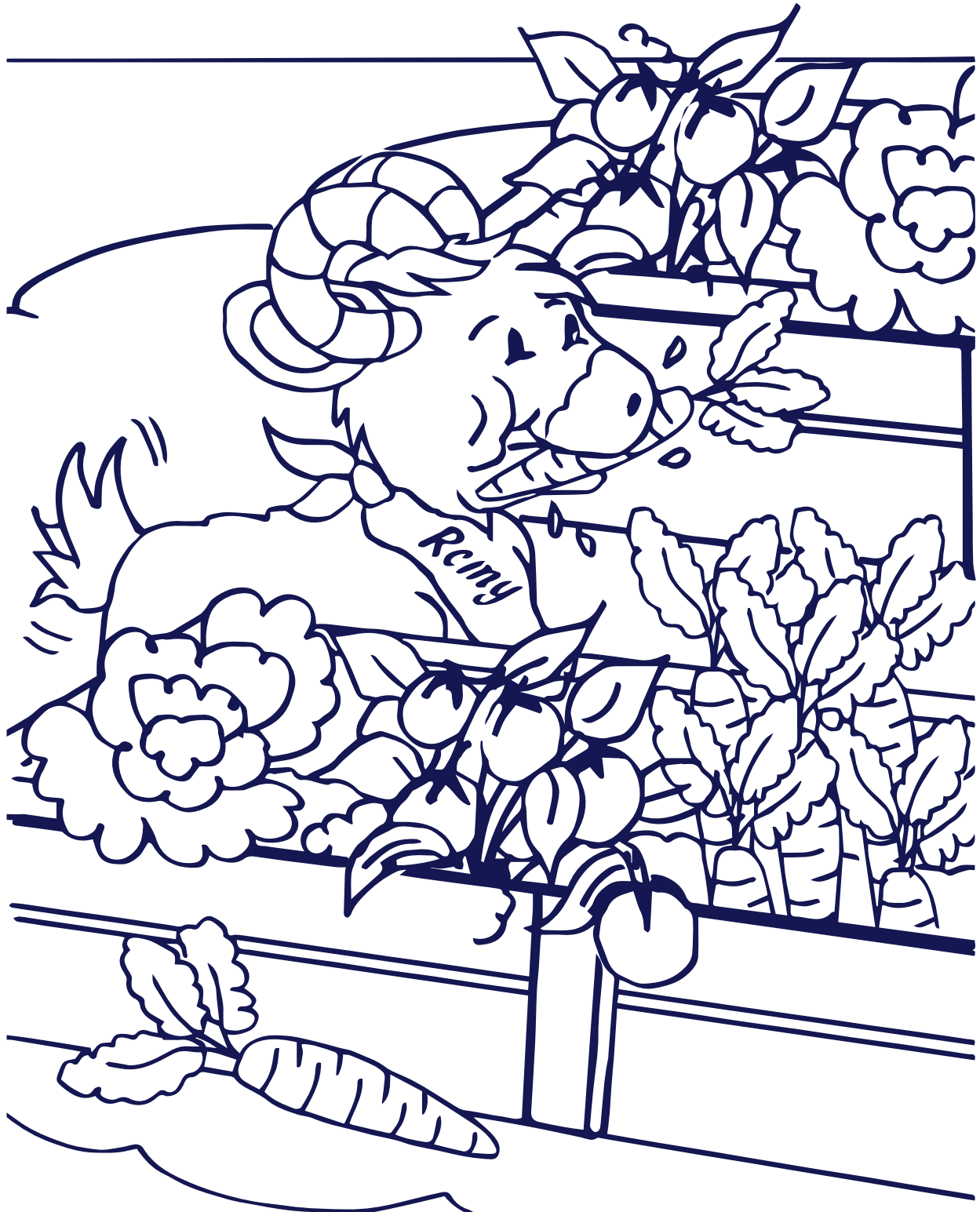
VISIT THE CHICK-INN

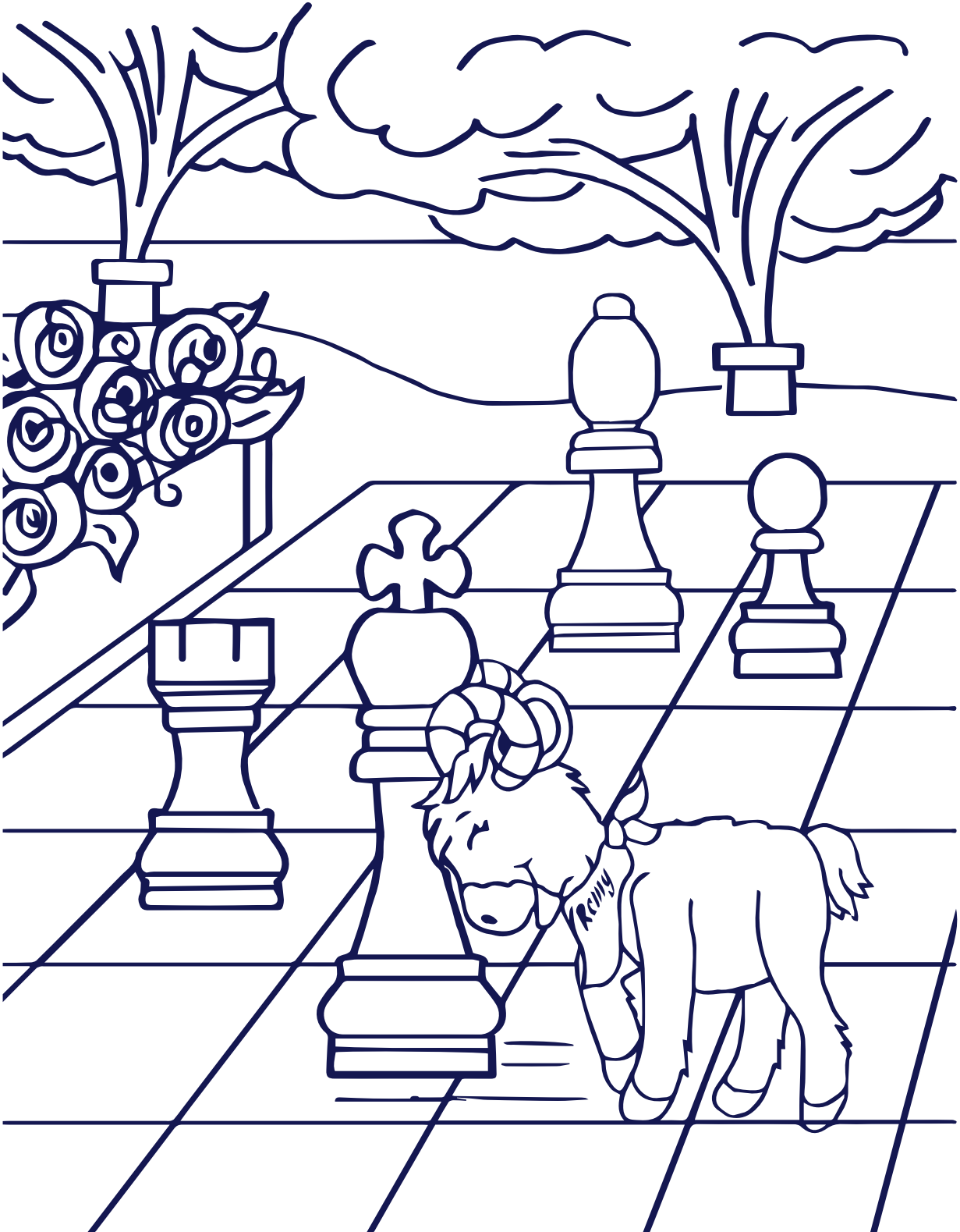
EXPLORE THE VEGETABLE GARDEN

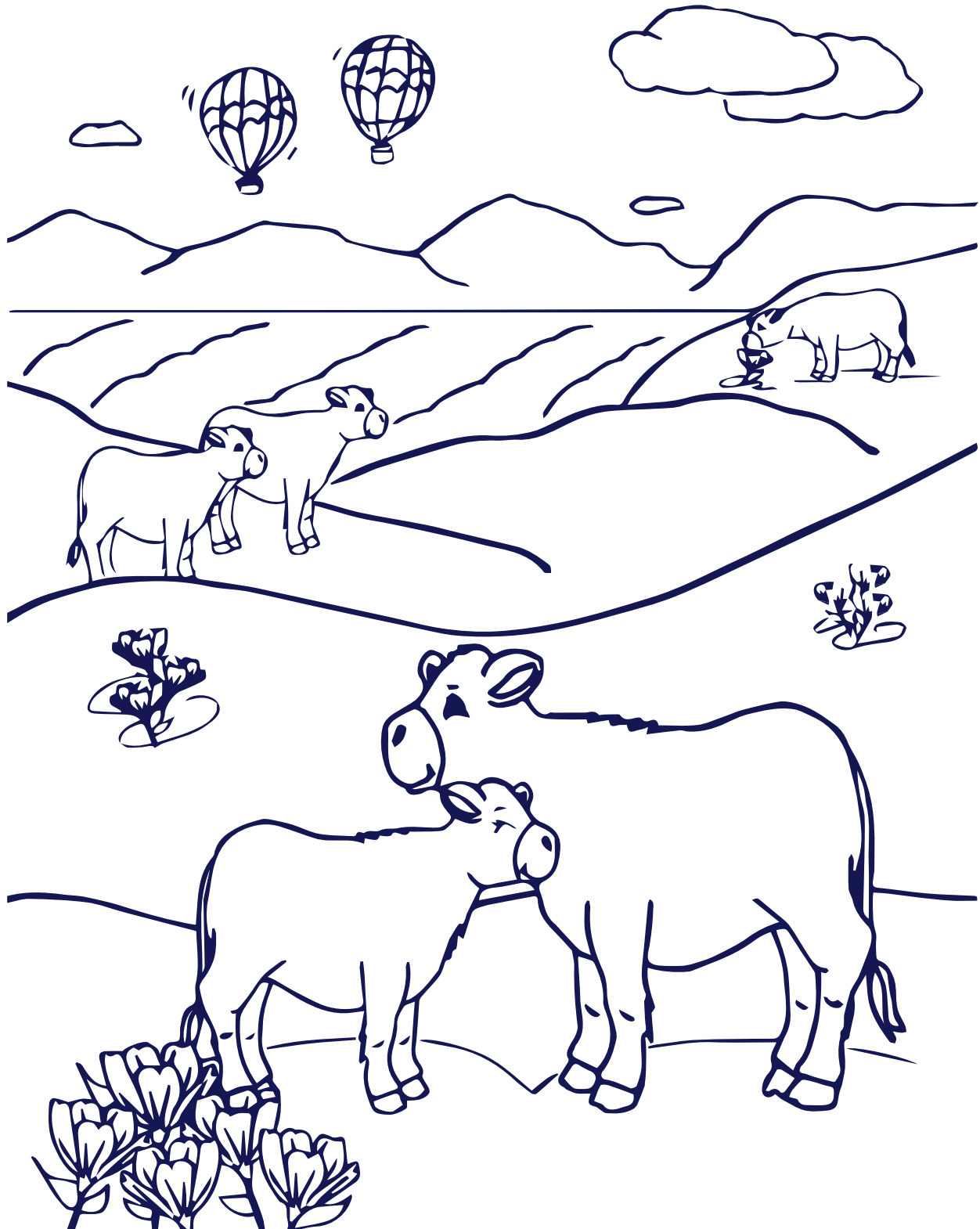
ROAST SOME S'MORES
